Spang’s previous community and board experience includes membership on the Lake Ridge Academy Alumni Board, Achievement Centers for Children, Co-Chair of the “Scrooge & Marley Ball,” The Cleveland Yacht Club Regatta Committee and The Red Cross. Spang received a Bachelor of Arts degree in art history and sociology from Lake Forest College, and pursued studies at the Cleveland Institute of Art and the Attingham Trust Summer Program in London, England.
